|                         | For the 'Fish passage Design and Installation' service, it is a requirement that the company must be able to provide both the design and construction services to apply for that scope of services?   | FBA intend to be able to approach suppliers under the preferred supplier list for full packages of work.  This is as it is unlikely the FBA would be able to obtain a design from one company and hand this over to a fish passage installer. Additionally, regulatory approvals, procurement of materials and groundwork require technical oversight that is not suited as separate services or for passing on to a civil company. FBA do not have in-house resources to support this function, which is why it has been opted to combine the scope for fish passage and design services under the preferred supplier list.  If tenderers plan to subcontract any aspect of the service (e.g. project management/ installation) this can be indicated within the ITT response. |
| 2                       | It is noted in Section 7 of Part 2 of 3 in the ITT there is reference to additional terms for the master agreement structure that are currently in development and to be released as an addendum to the ITT during the tender process.  Can this please be clarified as there has not been an Addendum issued with the ITT as of yet? | FBA advises that unfortunately the additional terms for the master agreement will not be finalised in time to be published with the ITT.  We kindly request that tenderers solely provide their departures for the existing terms within the ITT submission. The additional terms will be provided at a later stage throughout the process, prior to award notifications.   |
